



Slope Rules

- The following rules supplement the Slope Standing Orders (SOP's) held by the Base Facilities Manager and available in the ski hut.
- Tow can only be operated under the supervision of an instructor.
- The runout at the bottom of the slope is a safety area and must be kept clear at all times.
- Skis and poles should not be left unattended on the slope, and must be returned at the end of the lesson.
- All members must remain within the slope area at all times.
- Helmets are mandatory for any slope user under the age of 16 years.
- In the event of an accident on the slope your Instructor will advise action required.
- Members not abiding by the slope rules may be asked to leave.
